#### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

**AUTHORITY -** The Event shall be a **Kaos Custom Bikes Training Day/Timed Motorkhana Day** conducted under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, this Event will be conducted under and in accordance with any and all necessary Motorsport Australia COVID-19 Return to Race Strategy requirements at the time of the event, Speed Events Standing Regulations, these Supplementary regulations, and any further regulations or instructions which may be issued and shall be subject to Motorsport Permit Number: **324/0206/02** 

The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at <u>www.motorsport.org.au</u>.

**PROMOTERS -** The event will be promoted and organised by the BMW Drivers Club Melbourne Inc. (BMWDCM)

**THE EVENT** - The event will be known as the **BMWDCM Calder Park Driver Training, Motorkhana Day,** to be conducted at the Calder Park Thunderdome, 377 Calder Fwy, Calder Park, 3037, Victoria, on Sunday, June 2, 2024. Directions to the track, with maps, are attached at the end of this document.

This Event will include Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.

**ENTRIES -** Entries will open on **approval of these regs** and will close at 5pm on **June 27<sup>th</sup>**, **2024.** Entry forms must be completed on the **BMWDCM online entry system**, and all documents emailed back to <u>documents@bmwdcm.com.au</u>. No registration will be completed until full payment has been received and ALL documents are received completed. **The maximum number of entries shall be 40, accepted in order of receipt.** The Promoters reserve the right to stipulate the number of entries for the Event and select entries in excess of such number at their absolute discretion. Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

ENTRY FEES - BMWDCM Members - Entry fee will be \$150 per Driver.

ENTRY FEES NON-MEMBERS - Entry fee will be \$180 per Driver.

**DOCUMENT CHECK IN:** Document check will commence at 7.30 am.

**DRIVERS BRIEFING -** The attendance of all drivers is required at a Drivers Briefing to be held at 9.00 a.m. Sunday, June 2, 2024. Drivers who fail to attend may be liable for a penalty imposed by the Stewards or for denial of entry.

**COMPETITION –** The morning is a non-timed, non-competition driver training and practice event and sessions will begin at 10.00am on Sunday, June 2, 2024 (or sooner if all document check is completed on time). The Afternoon sessions will be timed Motorkhana layouts to be handed out on the day and the quickest time on each layout counts toward the Drivers Championship as per the BMWDCM points system. The afternoon timed sessions will begin after lunch at approximately 1pm on Sunday June 2, 2024, or any other time as determined by the promoters. The number of official runs will be disclosed in the Driver's Briefing notes.

**PERSONS ELIGIBLE -** The event shall be open female and male drivers. All drivers must hold a current Motorsport Australia Speed/Speed Junior or above licence and be a current member of a Motorsport Australia affiliated Car Club.

**SCRUTINEERING -** Scrutiny will be via a mix of self and targeted scrutineering. All entrants must sign a declaration that they have self-scrutineered their own car prior to commencement of track activities and during the event scrutineers may inspect any car at any time during the event to check that the car is safe to be on the track. Current membership cards, and a Motorsport Australia Speed/Speed Junior or higher licence must be produced on request throughout the event. A self-scrutiny declaration will be sent to competitors for their signing and return prior to the event. All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and B of the Motorsport Australia Manual. Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the

**TIMING –** The morning sessions will not be timed. The afternoon sessions will be timed by stopwatch or other electronic means and the Timekeeper for each layout will be a judge of fact.

AWARDS - Trophies will be awarded at the end of season function.

Motorsport Australia Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled.

**PROTESTS -** Any protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

**ABANDONMENT -** The Event Organisers reserve the right to abandon, postponed or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

**SAFETY – DRIVER -** Drivers must wear a helmet to a standard listed in the Motorsport Australia Manual and be deemed by the scrutineers of the event to be in a suitable condition for Motorsport use, nonflammable clothing, suitable footwear, and goggles or visors with lens other than glass in open cars (see Section 6, Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual).

**SAFETY – CARS -** The attention of competitors is drawn to Section 6 of the Motorsport Australia Manual in which all vehicle requirements are listed in detail. Silencers are mandatory, and vehicles must not exceed a noise limit of 75dB (A). Competitors are reminded that the possession and use of Halon/BCF fire extinguishers, other than where specific approval has been given by the E.P.A., is prohibited.

**INTEGRITY, ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES –** Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at <u>www.motorsport.org.au</u>. Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be

tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

**TRACK CONFIGURATION -** This event will be conducted on various Motorkhana style layouts that will be handed out at drivers briefing on the day.

**USE OF THE TRACK FOR PRACTICE -** The track will be available for unofficial practice on the morning of during the practice/training sessions of the event.

**SIGHTING LAPS-** Sighting laps will not be available; each timed run will count.

**COMPETING CARS** - Competing cars must be kept in the paddock area during the running of the event. Competitors' trailers must be parked in the designated areas and must not be parked in spectator areas.

**SPECTATORS** - Spectators are welcome and must stay away from the track area.

**ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES** – Entries are not accepted until all documents are received completed in full and payment has been received.

**INSURANCE –** Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at <u>www.motorsport.org.au</u>.

Directions from Melbourne:

- 1. Head west on Calder Freeway from city or Ring Road
- 2. Use the left lane to take the Calder Cark entry Gate.
- 3. Come though the security gate and enter the venue.
- 4. Once through gate perform left hand U turn through tunnel into Thunderdome.
- 5. Follow Road to parking area
- 6. Marshals will direct you where to park depending on if you are a car or have a trailer.
